- 2. COLLECT EXHIBITOR CARDS FROM THE TABLE UNDER THIS BANNER AND WRITE YOUR NAME, ADDRESS AND CLASS ENTRY NUMBER(S) ON THESE. WHEN COMPLETING EXHIBITOR CARDS FOR SCHOOL YEARS 7 – 11, ADD (A) AFTER THE CLASS NUMBER - FOR SCHOOL YEARS 12 & 13 ADD (B) AFTER THE CLASS NUMBER.**
- 3. WHERE POSSIBLE PLEASE BRING YOUR EXHIBITS YOURSELF.**
- 4. Plates and cellophane will be provided.**
- 5. The Marquee will be open from 2.00pm – 10pm on Friday 30th June and from 6.30am – 8.45am on Saturday 1st July. The Marquee will be closed at 8.45am for judging and NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS TIME.**

VEGETABLES AND FLOWERS

THE NORTH TROPHY WILL BE AWARDED FOR BEST EXHIBIT IN CLASSES 1 - 7

CLASS 1A / 1B POTATOES

Grow a potato in a large flower pot or an old compost bag rolled down- make a few drainage holes with a sharp instrument. Harvest ALL the potatoes and bring to the Show in a container where they can be seen easily.

Getting started:

Put the potato somewhere in the light (a windowsill or similar) where it can start to shoot – this is called “chitting”.

In April after the risk of frost, quarter fill the container with multi purpose compost – leave 2 shoots on the potato removing the others, put the potato in centre of the compost and completely cover with compost. When leaves show completely cover again and continue until 10cm from top of container.

CLASS 2A / 2B A CARROT (JUDGED FOR ITS FUNNY SHAPE)

Fill a large flower pot with multi purpose compost- make a shallow drill and sow a row of carrot seed. When seedlings are about 10cm high remove every other one, this is to give carrots left room to grow. DON'T FORGET TO WATER. Wash your entry before exhibiting. Do not remove the leaves.

CLASS 3A / 3B A BUNCH OF SIX RADISHES

Sow two rows of radish seeds (in the same pot as the carrots). Pull up in readiness for Show Day leaving the leaves on. Wash and tie 6 in a bunch.

CLASS 4A / 4B A POT OF HERBS

Sow herb seeds of your choice in a 15cm pot and exhibit in the pot. Remember to name the herb.

CLASS 5A / 5B POT OF CALENDULA (MARIGOLD)

Sow a few seeds spaced out in a 15cm flower pot. Exhibit in the pot.

CLASS 6A / 6B CACTI / SUCCULENTS

Arranged in a bowl no larger than 30cm.

CLASS 7A / 7B ALPINES

Arranged in a bowl no larger than 30cm.
